Pets at NimbleFingers



There are a limited number of pet friendly sites at Sorrento Centre. To make sure your pet can be accommodated, we ask that you inform us at time of booking if you are travelling with a pet.

There is a daily fee of \$10.00 day/per pet (cabanas) and \$5.00 day/per pet (campground). Each space has a limit of 2 pets.

We appreciate that your pet is a member of your family; however, we must also keep the comfort and safety of other guests and staff in mind. It is our top priority that all guests enjoy their stay so please abide by the following guidelines:

- Pets reservations are only permitted in the reserved cabanas and RV/tent sites.
- Pets are not permitted in the kitchen, dining areas, lodges, beach, Kekuli or in classes/workshops.
- Pets must be on a leash or in a carrier at all times when on Sorrento Centre property, except while in your RV or tent.
- Leashed and haltered service dogs are welcome.

Always pick up after your pet! Please respect the Sorrento Centre grounds and surrounding properties by picking up after your pet. Should your pet have any accidents on the premises, please clean up after them promptly or ask for assistance if required. Disposal bags are available at the front desk at no extra charge and are to be disposed of in outdoor garbage receptacles only.

Owners are responsible for the behaviour of their pets at all times, and they are financially responsible for any damages to Sorrento Centre caused by their pet. Animals exhibiting aggressive behaviour or posing a risk to guests will be asked to leave.

*Note from NimbleFingers—Thanks everyone for working together on this. We appreciate the feedback on the evaluation sheets and via email. Please keep in mind there are participants in camp who are allergic, afraid, or really just do not like being around dogs. It's important to provide a space that is welcoming to everyone.

Unless your dog absolutely has to come with you, we urge you to consider leaving them at home.
